the primary traits from a linge found in longrage. He applied a statistical technique, called factor analysis, to discover the common Structures. On the basis of statiscal mellind he glines only Trait Clusters en place o trails. According to him trait clusters com be described not defined. Cattell describes two lipses of trails. He found remary or source trails. He source traits are stable, and are considered as the building blocks , personality. Besides these dre also a member of surface trails that results out of the interaction of source Cattell described the brails en terms of opposing l'endencres.
